Challenge: Photo of a garden bench, patio, stone or other sitting area within the surrounds of a garden, and which depicts a serene and restful place to sit and reflect on the beauty of a garden. **Cinematic Theme:** *"The Secret Garden"*, (1993)

Location: Open

Entries: 11

Judge's Comments: "This [winning] image invokes a feeling of a serene place to sit, with a wellbalanced composition of light, shade and colour tones."

Challenge: Whet our appetites with images of your best edible garden harvest (*fruits, vegetables, edible flowers*). Can be an in-ground single item or collection, a garden bed, or an artfully posed harvested display.

Cinematic Theme: *"Fried Green Tomatoes", (1991)*

Location: National Capital Region

Entries: 8

Judge's comments: "Some thought clearly went into creating a pleasing composition for the winning entry which stood out from the rest in this category. The diagonal background, splash of water etc. The exposure could have been better but was still better then the other entries presented in the category."

Judge's comments: "The winning entry for this category has a very strong composition but the quality of the image itself does have some flaws. I like this image a lot and despite its flaws it still stands out as the best in category."

Cinematic Theme: "Dare to be Wild", (2015)
Location: National Capital Area
Entries: 11
Judge's comments: "The winning entry here had a decent composition. Though not perfect, it was more pleasing than the other entries. The exposure is not correct so that hurts it as well. That being said, it is the best in category and if the exposure were fixed (it is underexposed between 1/2-3/4 stops) it would have been in the top 5 overall in the competition."
